Fairview Beloved,

If you close your eyes for two minutes and listen to what is around you - what do you hear? I hear the faint sound of Kathy's music in the other office. I hear the traffic down the road on Antioch. I hear the slight roar of a plane overhead. I hear someone mowing their lawn in the distance, the tapping of fingers on a keyboard, with all of

it wrapped in a background of silence. Noise disrupts the silence, but it's always there with these interruptions - birds chirping, air conditioners blowing....but in the background, nothingness.

Buddhists meditate to transcend the disruption. They spend minutes to hours a day trying to overcome the disruption of the world, of the earth, of the things around them. Meditating to transcend suffering, pressure.....they float above into the background silence....it takes practice and dedication to the art of it all. I could never be a Buddhist.

The disruption and the noise is, for me, where God is. In the daily rhythms of life and the random orchestra of life around me. God is present in the here and in the now. In the music and the travel of those in planes. In the creativity and work of a keyboard and the care of the earth on a lawn mower. For me, God is in relationship. Relationship with others and relationship with the earth.

For others, God is in the silence and in the outside of what wraps all of this chaos up. God speaks to us in different ways because we are different people. One is not better than the other or more right.

They both just are because we all just are.

Somehow it has gotten lost that it's ok for both to be right. It is okay for you to do one thing and me another. It isn't a competition.....it's a rhythm. It's the rhythm of our souls and how God's music plays to each of our hearts. Both are right.

The next time you find yourself feeling the absolute need to be right, ask why and then think about how both could be right.
